This Privacy Notice for Evgeny Nikiforov, trading as Roundwise ("we," "us," or "our"), describes how and why we might access, collect, store, use, and/or share ("process") your personal information when you use our services ("Services"), including when you:

- Use Roundwise — an AI-powered interview preparation platform that helps users practice technical and behavioral interviews through simulated interview sessions, personalized feedback, and tailored recommendations. The Service allows users to provide interview answers via voice or text and interact with AI models to improve their interview performance. The platform is intended solely for interview preparation and does not provide employment, recruiting, or professional career advice.

## Summary of Key Points

**What personal information do we process?** When you visit, use, or navigate our Services, we may process personal information depending on how you interact with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use.

**Do we process any sensitive personal information?** We do not process sensitive personal information.

**Do we collect any information from third parties?** We do not collect any information from third parties.

**How do we process your information?** We process your information to provide, improve, and administer our Services, communicate with you, for security and fraud prevention, and to comply with law. We may also process your information for other purposes with

your consent. We process your information only when we have a valid legal reason to do so.

In what situations and with which parties do we share personal information? We may share information in specific situations and with specific third parties, including our payment processor Paddle.

How do we keep your information safe? We have adequate organizational and technical processes and procedures in place to protect your personal information. However, no electronic transmission over the internet or information storage technology can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

What are your rights? Depending on where you are located geographically, the applicable privacy law may mean you have certain rights regarding your personal information.

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## 1. What Information Do We Collect?

### Personal information you disclose to us

**In Short:** We collect personal information that you provide to us.

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you register on the Services, express an interest in obtaining information about us or our products and Services, when you participate in activities on the Services, or otherwise when you contact us.

**Personal Information Provided by You.** The personal information we collect may include the following:

- Names
- Email addresses
- Job titles and career information (role, specialization, experience level)
- Interview answers and responses (text and voice recordings)
- Contact or authentication data

**Payment Information.** We do not directly collect or store your payment card details. All payment processing is handled by Paddle.com Market Limited ("Paddle"), which acts as our Merchant of Record. When you make a purchase, your payment information is collected and processed directly by Paddle in accordance with their [Privacy Policy](#). We

only receive confirmation of your subscription status and transaction reference from Paddle.

**Sensitive Information.** We do not process sensitive information.

**Social Media Login Data.** We may provide you with the option to register with us using your existing social media account details, like your Google account. Where you choose to do this, we will receive certain profile information from your social media provider, typically your name, email address, and profile picture.

All personal information that you provide to us must be true, complete, and accurate, and you must notify us of any changes to such personal information.

## **Information automatically collected**

**In Short:** Some information — such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address and/or browser and device characteristics — is collected automatically when you visit our Services.

We automatically collect certain information when you visit, use, or navigate the Services. This information does not reveal your specific identity but may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use our Services, and other technical information.

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## 2. How Do We Process Your Information?

**In Short:** We process your information to provide, improve, and administer our Services, communicate with you, for security and fraud prevention, and to comply with law.

We process your personal information for a variety of reasons, including:

- To facilitate account creation and authentication and otherwise manage user accounts.
  - To deliver and facilitate delivery of services to the user, including generating AI-powered feedback on interview answers.
  - To process payments and subscriptions through our Merchant of Record, Paddle.
  - To request feedback and to contact you about your use of our Services.
  - To send you marketing and promotional communications, if this is in accordance with your marketing preferences. You can opt out at any time.
  - To protect our Services, including fraud monitoring and prevention.
  - To identify usage trends so we can improve the Services.
  - To save or protect an individual's vital interest.
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## 3. What Legal Bases Do We Rely On to Process Your Information?

**In Short:** We only process your personal information when we believe it is necessary and we have a valid legal reason to do so under applicable law.

If you are located in the EU or UK, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and UK GDPR require us to explain the valid legal bases we rely on:

- **Consent.** You have given us permission to use your personal information for a specific purpose. You can withdraw your consent at any time.
  - **Performance of a Contract.** Processing is necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations to you, including providing our Services.
  - **Legitimate Interests.** Processing is reasonably necessary to achieve our legitimate business interests (e.g., analyzing usage, improving the Services, fraud prevention), provided those interests do not outweigh your rights and freedoms.
  - **Legal Obligations.** Processing is necessary for compliance with our legal obligations.
  - **Vital Interests.** Processing is necessary to protect your vital interests or those of a third party.
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## 4. When and With Whom Do We Share Your Personal Information?

**In Short:** We may share information in specific situations and with the following third parties.

We may need to share your personal information in the following situations:

- **Payment Processing.** We share necessary information with Paddle.com Market Limited, our Merchant of Record, to process your subscription payments and manage billing. Paddle processes this data in accordance with their own Privacy Policy.
  - **AI Service Providers.** Your interview answers and related inputs are processed by third-party AI providers, including OpenAI and Anthropic, to generate feedback. These providers process data in accordance with their respective privacy policies and data processing agreements.
  - **Analytics Providers.** We use Google Analytics to understand how users interact with our Services.
  - **Business Transfers.** We may share or transfer your information in connection with any merger, sale of assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
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## 5. Do We Use Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies?

**In Short:** We may use cookies and other tracking technologies to collect and store your information.

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## **7. How Do We Handle Your Social Logins?**

**In Short: If you choose to register or log in using a social media account (e.g., Google), we may have access to certain information about you.**

**The profile information we receive may include your name, email address, and profile picture. We will use the information we receive only for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice. We recommend that you review the privacy notice of your social media provider.**

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## **8. How Long Do We Keep Your Information?**

**In Short: We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Notice unless otherwise required by law.**

**We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is necessary, unless a longer retention period is required by law (such as tax, accounting, or other legal requirements). No purpose in this notice will require us keeping your personal information for longer than twelve (12) months past the termination of the user's account.**

**When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize such information.**

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## 9. How Do We Keep Your Information Safe?

**In Short:** We aim to protect your personal information through organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate and reasonable technical and organizational security measures. However, no electronic transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Transmission of personal information to and from our Services is at your own risk.

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## 10. Do We Collect Information from Minors?

**In Short:** We do not knowingly collect data from or market to children under 18 years of age.

We do not knowingly collect, solicit data from, or market to children under 18 years of age. By using the Services, you represent that you are at least 18.
